## Council Meeting Synopsis:

**December 14, 2010:** Utility rates were a topic of discussion at this meeting. The council accepted public comment and also received submitted letters and comments. Following a public hearing the council adopted an increase of \$0.35 per thousand gallons of usage increase to the sewer portion of the bill. Action was also taken to amend previous actions regarding floodplain management. The corrected documents were adopted and the Village is once again in compliance with FEMA and State regulations. 2011 council meeting dates and the Village Manager contract were also agenda items that received action.



Two grants were also discussed. A grant application for the Michigan Economic Development Corporation Community Development Block Grant Farm to Food Farmer's Market was approved. This grant will replace, enhance, and add infrastructure to Washington Park. If the application is approved the Village will receive almost \$220,000 from the State. The council also approved submitting a grant pre-application for a Michigan Economic Development Corporation Community Development Block Grant Downtown Infrastructure Grant. If Bellevue were fortunate enough to be selected for this grant then we would receive up to \$750,000 for infrastructure in the downtown district, such as streets, sidewalks, lighting, trash receptacles, and planters.

**December 28, 2010:** The council took care of three agenda items at their regular meeting on December 28. These were the adoption of the 2011 Village of Bellevue Budget, making appointments to the Bellevue Joint Planning Commission, and adopting amendments to the 2010 Village of Bellevue Budget. The meeting also included a public hearing regarding the 2011 budget where the council accepted comments from community members in attendance.
