Memorial Day Parade:

American Legion Post 280, our local post, will be holding the annual Memorial Day Parade. Memorial Day this year is on Monday, May 26. The parade line up will begin at 9:30 a.m. and the parade will begin at 10:00 a.m.

Flushing Water Mains:

The Village will be flushing water mains on Wednesday, April 30 and Thursday, May 1 to remove accumulated sediments. While flushing doesn't affect the safety of the water supply, tap water may appear cloudy or discolored immediately after flushing. The Village is advising residents to run their cold water in their bathtub or utility sink until it runs clear again, and is discouraging them from using their washing machines the day of flushing and for 24 hours after, since clothing could become discolored.



Bellevue Farmer's Market:
