At the November 4, 2014 General Election, residents of the Village of Bellevue will be electing representatives to serve on the Village Council. The Village President Seat, three 4-year Trustee seats, and one 2-year partial term Trustee seat will appear on the ballot.



Flushing Water Mains:

The Village will be flushing water mains on Wednesday, October 15 and Thursday, October 16 to remove accumulated sediments. While flushing doesn't affect the safety of the water supply, tap water may appear cloudy or discolored immediately after flushing. The Village is advising residents to run their cold water in their bathtub or utility sink until it runs clear again.
