Memorial Day Parade:

American Legion Post 280, our local post, will be holding the annual Memorial Day Parade. Memorial Day this year is on Monday, May 25. The parade line up will begin at 9:30 a.m. and the parade will begin at 10:00 a.m.



A short memorial will be at the bridge for our salute to The Navy, Coast Guard and Merchant seaman and at the flag pole in Washington Park to honor the firefighters. The parade will then go on to the cemetery for other memorial presentations.

Flushing Water Mains:

The Village will be flushing water mains on Tuesday, April 28 and Wednesday, April 29 to remove accumulated sediments. Tap water may appear cloudy or discolored immediately after flushing. The Village is advising residents to run their cold water in their bathtub or utility sink until it runs clear again, and is discouraging them from using their washing machines the day of flushing and for 24 hours after, since clothing could become discolored.



Bellevue Farmer's Market:
