Flushing Water Mains



The Village will be flushing water mains on Wednesday, October 14 and Thursday, October 15 to remove accumulated sediments. While flushing doesn't affect the safety of the water supply, tap water may appear cloudy or discolored immediately after flushing. The Village is advising residents to run their cold water in their bathtub or utility sink until it runs clear again.
