Such application shall be accompanied by the following:

- A certificate from the Sealer of Weights and Measures certifying that all weighing and measuring devices to be used by the applicant have been examined and approved.
- 2. A letter of authorization from the person, firm or corporation that the applicant purports to represent.
- 3. Two photographs, at least two inches by two inches in size, clearly showing the head and shoulders of the applicant, one of which shall be attached to the license and the other of which shall be retained by Village Hall.
- 4. An application for a license as a solicitor who demands, accepts or receives payment or deposit of money in advance of final delivery shall also be accompanied by a bond to the Village of Bellevue, approved as to form by the Village Attorney, in the sum of \$5,000, with a sufficient surety or sureties or sufficient collateral security, conditioned for making a final delivery of the goods, wares or merchandise ordered or services to be performed in accordance with the terms of such order or, failing therein, that the advance payment of such order be refunded. Any person aggrieved by the action of any licensed solicitor shall have the right of action on said bond for the recovery of money or damages, or both. Such bond shall remain in full force and effect, and in case of a cash deposit, the Village of Bellevue shall retain such deposit for a period of 90 days after the expiration of any such license unless sooner released by Village Hall.
