- H. Coy resolved to appoint N. Roberts to sign all MDOT Trunkline Contracts as needed for the Village of Bellevue, seconded by B. Balkema. Motion carried.

The council discussed the Central Business District Zoning Ordinance and what was allowed and what was not. N. Roberts is going to do some more investigation to review at the next meeting. Jake Jackson confirmed that the Fire Department is still installing smoke and carbon monoxide detectors for free in homes. Residents just need to call the fire department to set up an appointment. Spring Clean-Up is May 4th; we are looking for volunteers if anyone can help.
